You can apply for a mail-in ballot using a paper application, online at vote.pa.gov or in person at your county elections office.

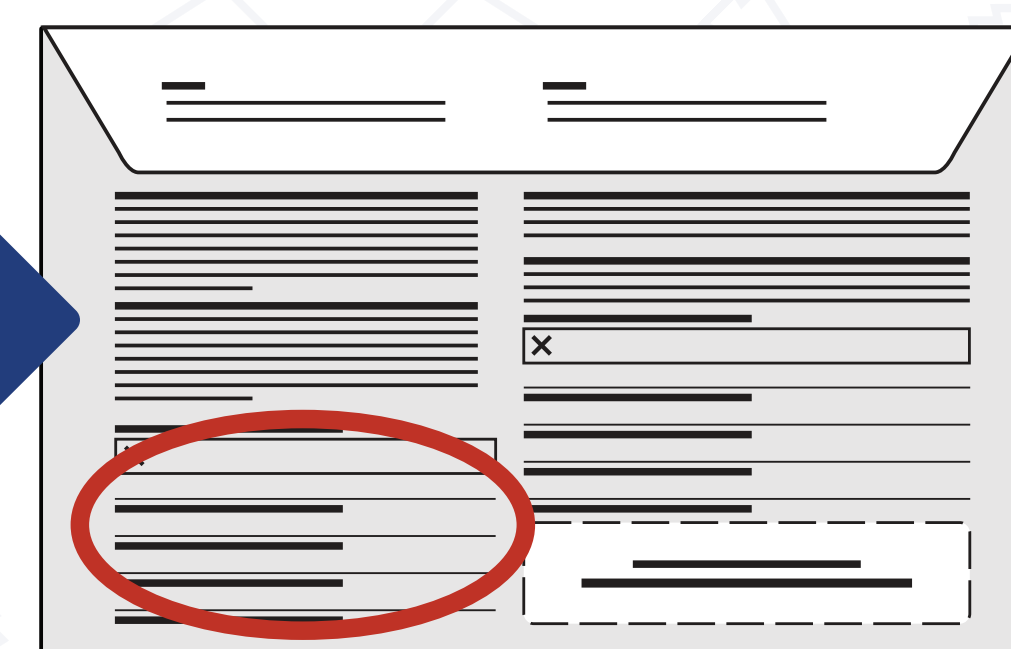
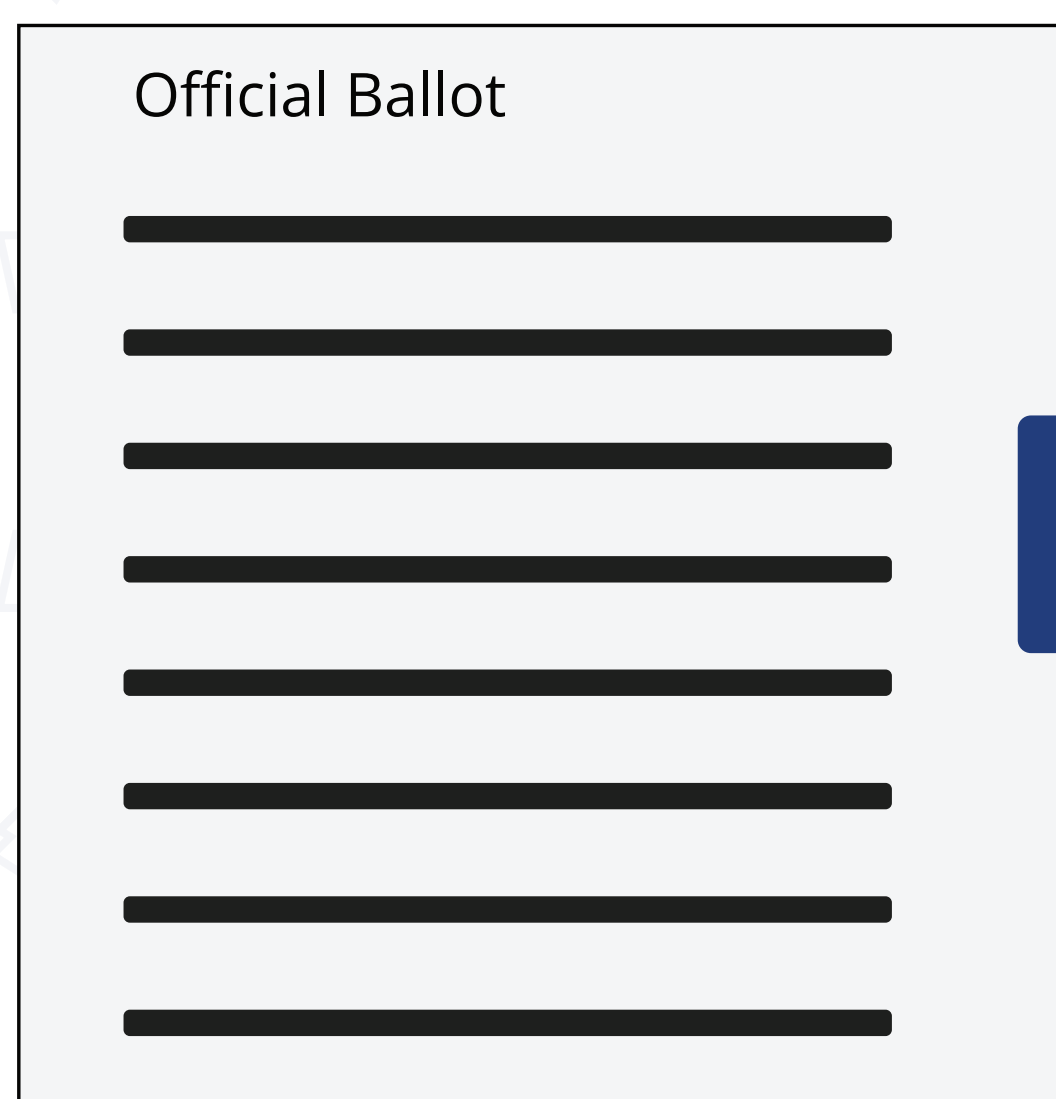
HOW TO RETURN YOUR MAIL-IN BALLOT

OFFICIAL BALLOT

INNER SECRECY ENVELOPE MARKED

"OFFICIAL ELECTION BALLOT"

PRE-ADDRESSED OUTER RETURN ENVELOPE



SIGN & DATE HERE

Make sure to seal your ballot in the inner secrecy envelope marked "Official Election Ballot" AND seal that into the pre-addressed outer return envelope. Complete, sign, and enter the current date on the outer return envelope. Your ballot will be counted only if it is sealed in both envelopes and the outer envelope is signed and dated. You can return only your own ballot unless you are a voter with a disability who has designated someone in writing to return it for you.
