ABSENTEE BALLOT

VOTING

Voters who plan to vote by absentee ballot can download an absentee ballot application form at votespa.com/absentee (PDF).

Print, complete and sign the application. Deliver or mail the application to your local county elections office. The address for your local county elections and voter registration office can be found at votespa.com/county.

The county board of elections must **receive your application for absentee ballot** no later than 5:00 p.m. on the Tuesday before the election. **A postmark is not sufficient.**

To avoid late delivery by the U.S. Postal Service, the Department of State recommends that voters submit their absentee ballot applications at least two weeks before the election.

Your county board of elections must **receive your voted absentee ballot** by 5:00 p.m. on the Friday before the election. **A postmark is not sufficient.**
