


HOW TO RETURN YOUR MAIL-IN BALLOT




1. COMPLETE YOUR BALLOT

Read the instructions and make your selections carefully.




2. SECRECY ENVELOPE

Put your ballot in the white inner secrecy envelope that indicates official ballot and seal it.



3. OUTER RETURN ENVELOPE

Place the secrecy envelope inside the pre-addressed outer return envelope where you must sign.




4. SIGN AND DATE IT

Fill in the Voter's Declaration on the pre-addressed return envelope. Make sure to sign and date it.




RETURNING BY MAIL

Your voted ballot must be postmarked by 8 p.m. on November 3 and received by 5 p.m. on November 6. No postage necessary.



RETURNING IN-PERSON

Your voted ballot must be received by the county board of elections by 8 p.m. on November 3.



RETURNING AT DROP BOX

Your voted ballot must be received by the county board of elections by 8 p.m. on November 3.

NOTICE: For your vote to count, you must return your ballot in the white inner secrecy envelope that indicates official ballot AND the pre-addressed outer return envelope where you must sign, by the deadline. You must return your own ballot unless you are a voter with a disability who has designated an agent in writing.
